APUA Hosts Training for Solar PV System Installation

Under the banner of its Green Antigua campaign APUA hosted 25 candidates during a one week training program on Photovoltaic Design & Installation.

The intense training course which ran from September 24th to September 28th was conducted by the internationally accredited company, Solar Energy International. This allowed a cross section of members from the private and public sector, to develop skills in the areas of designing and installing solar energy systems. They were exposed to a theoretical and practical component and will continue their training online to learn how to install battery based systems. The 25 candidates are now officially recognized by the Authority as Certified Installers

This training initiative is part of the first phase of the roll out of the newly instated Interconnection Policy. This policy permits private homes and businesses to generate their own power supply from alternative energy sources such as wind and solar. .

Phase two of the roll out of the Interconnection Policy will speak to educating the public on the policy and its benefits. It will also open the registration process for those individuals who are ready to have a system installed on their homes. The Interconnection Policy is one of the initiatives APUA has instituted in efforts to become an environmentally conscious company.
