The APUA Water Police

In recognition of World Water Day, celebrated on March 22nd annually, the APUA Water Business Unit installed Water Police in six primary schools; the Green Bay Primary School, Willikies Primary School, Pares Primary School, JT Ambrose Primary School, Wesleyan Junior Academy and the Potters Primary School. These selected Grade 5 students will be responsible for monitoring the communal water areas in their respective schools. As we continue the International Year of Water Cooperation countries around the world have been asked to find ways to ensure that water is accessible to all citizens. In Antigua & Barbuda it is important that residents begin to implement conservation practices to ensure that water is remains available to the general population. The Water Police are a part of APUA's new Green Antigua program which seeks to create a conservation culture in Antigua & Barbuda. Upon the success of this first batch of students the program will be expanded to include other schools.
