Tampering with Electricity Services

The APUA Electricity Business Unit has recently been responding to a number of calls in regards to cut service wires on electricity meters. These incidents have been occurring most frequently between the hours of 12AM and 4AM in St John's City and its outskirts. The Authority is asking all residents to be vigilant and to report any suspicious behavior to the police. If you have experienced an electricity outage, please check the neighboring houses/businesses to ensure that it is not an isolated incident. If your home/business is the only one without electricity please call our 24 hour electricity fault line at 311. APUA implores residents not to attempt to try and reconnect or go near to the meter or service wires if this incident occurs. Tampering with APUA equipment and entering onto private property is a criminal activity and perpetrators will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.
