Copper Line Theft

On the evening of Monday 25th August a section of copper wire was stolen from the telecommunications network that runs between the Coolidge Exchange and New Winthropes. As a result of this theft, residents in New Winthropes, Barnes Hill and Judges Hill have been without landline and inet. Restoration work is ongoing and is forecasted to be completed by 2:00pm on Wednesday 27th September.
